Workshop on Theories of Science and Philosophy, Part II
2nd -9th November 2016, Churchill Court Hotel**

Building Stronger Universities II Project at Gulu University is organizing an 8-day workshop on Theories of Science and Philosophy, a continuation of Part I held in January 2016. This graduate course aims to provide MA and Ph.D. students at Gulu University with an overview of central theories of science and philosophy that have formed the basis for critical work in the social sciences. The workshop will introduce theories of Western and African knowledge traditions, pragmatism, post-structuralism, archaeology of knowledge, feminist theory, and environmental issues. It will include a section on methodology in analysis and writing.

The format for the course will be lectures, films, workshops and discussions groups, all facilitated by Dr. Inger Sjørsvlev and Dr. Susan Reynolds Whyte from University of Copenhagen, and Dr. Lioba Lenhart and other staff from Gulu University.

It is an overall ambition of the organisers that students should be able to relate the lectures and text readings to their individual research projects, so that the course becomes not only informative and an exercise in reading complex texts, but also a training course in analytical methods. The general learning objectives are:

- To become acquainted with main currents in 20th and 21st century philosophy of science.
- To improve thesis work by integrating knowledge about philosophy of science.
- To gain knowledge about method of analysis and thesis structuring.
- To become aware of the character of academic writing and improve knowledge about the academic genre.

Applications are therefore invited from Gulu University members pursuing MA and Ph.D. degrees. All applications for the course must include a brief presentation (max 2 pages) of their projects, including:

- working title for the project
- brief description of objectives, theories, and proposed methods
- summary of progress to date and the time plan for completion
- very brief cv
